Things that you cannot bring:


- Latex Paint

Latex Paint is non-hazardous and not accepted at collections. The next **useable** latex paint exchange is May 30th at Ecostores Nebraska (530 W. P St.) Ecostores also disposes of unusable paint for \$5/can.
