PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

PERMITS ARE REQUIRED for all new construction and/or structural changes made to any existing buildings. This includes change of land usage; new development; subdivisions; fences and signs.

The replacement of permanently wired fixed-in-place appliances including, but not limited to, furnaces, air conditioners, garbage disposals, dishwashers and water heaters shall be subject to permit requirements. No permit is required to replace an electrical appliance that has a cord and plugs into an outlet (i.e. garage door opener)

If you plan to build or remodel, it is YOUR responsibility to obtain the necessary permits.

Many permit applications can be found online at www.hickman.ne.gov, under City Services, forms & permits. Permits are also available at the Hickman City Hall, 115 Locust Street.
