**All golf car vehicles must be registered with the City. The City will provide the vehicle owner a proof of registration sticker to be displayed on the rear of the vehicle.**

- 2) proof of insurance provided; and**
- 3) a registration fee of \$25.00 paid.**

**All registrations shall expire on December 31st of each calendar year.**
