## Get a City Building Permit Before You Start Your Home Improvement Project

To ensure building safety the City of Hickman requires a building permit for most home improvement projects, including sheds and fences. Building permit forms are available at the City Office or can be emailed upon request. Call 402.792.2212 or e-mail request to [heidih@hickman.ne.gov](mailto:heidih@hickman.ne.gov)

All permits must be approved before work begins. Structures or changes to structures without a building permit shall be deemed and considered a public nuisance and may be abated or removed by the City at the expense of the owner.
