GOLF CAR REGISTRATION



All golf car vehicles must be registered with the City. The City will provide the vehicle owner a proof of registration sticker to be displayed on the rear of the vehicle.

To obtain a registration sticker or tag from the City:

- 1) a signed registration form must be completed;**
- 2) proof of insurance provided; and**
- 3) a registration fee of \$25.00 paid.**

All registrations shall expire on December 31st of each calendar year.
