NOTICE TO RESIDENTS OF HICKMAN Reminder of the City of Hickman Municipal Codes:

Chapter 6-302 It is the duty of the occupant of each lot to keep the sidewalk free of overhanging branches and limbs to a height of eight (8) feet and keep shrubbery and hedges from encroaching on the sidewalk.

Chapter 6-304 Sidewalk Maintenance – Every owner of any lot shall at all times keep and maintain the sidewalk contiguous to said lot in good and proper repair and in a condition reasonably safe for travel.
