You Can Pay Your Utility Bill Online

For those of you who are having problems locating the City's online utility payment portal, make sure that you have first cleared the old Hickman website from your web browser's cache. The newly designed website has a picture of the Hickman Community Center on its homepage. You may need to re-type in the web address: www.hickman.ne.gov Click on City Utilities tab, scroll down to Online Bill View and Payment. Click on the PayPort image link that appears at the top of the payment page. You will need your customer number and total amount due, which is located on your utility bill. Follow the Payport instructions.
