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





# Since 2010, Nebraska's population has increased 7.4% but 69 counties have lost population


Percent change in population 2010 - 2020 2020 total population = 1,961,504






### 65% of Nebraska's population lived in a metro county in 2020


Percent of population that live in metropolitan (11) and nonmetropolitan counties (82)






### Our population pyramid is not much of a pyramid





# Nebraska's growth rate is driven by natural change and mild international migration


Components of population change 2010 to 2022






# Brain drain, or net-outmigration of persons with a bachelor's degree or more, has persisted since 2010 and the trend is negative

Net migration by educational attainment annually 2010 to 2021



# Nebraskans are most likely to move within the Midwest and states with a high rate of job openings


2021 job openings rate base color and 2020 number of Nebraska domestic out-migrants










Nebraska population 25 years and older educational attainment 2010 to 2021
