HICKMAN BRUSH PILE KEYS

Brush Pile Keys are available at City Hall from 8 AM to 5 PM, Monday through Friday. The facility is for residents living within Hickman City Limits only. Keys can be checked out and returned to the drop box outside City Hall or the front desk **within 24 hours**.

**THE BRUSH PILE IS LIMITED TO DISPOSAL OF ONLY
THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:**

TREE LIMBS LEAVES SHRUBS GRASS CLIPPINGS

Trash, lumber and bags are prohibited. Lost keys are subject to a \$25.00 replacement fee. Please continue to use this space properly as this is a great amenity the City offers through a permit issued by the Lincoln Lancaster County Health Department. Failure to follow the brush pile regulations could result in revocation of the permit and closure of the site.



TRAILERS, RV'S & MOTOR HOMES



The City of Hickman prohibits the parking of any trailer, bus, mobile home, tractor-trailer, or any vehicle that exceeds 20 feet in length or 7 feet in width on city streets for more than 2 hours.

FRIENDLY REMINDER

This is a *friendly reminder* to mow and maintain your property in Hickman and license all vehicles on the property that are not housed in a garage or building.

All unlicensed and inoperable vehicles that are not housed inside must be removed from the property along with any junk or litter. We take great pride in our community and want to encourage everyone to be a good neighbor.

According to Municipal Code Section 3-502, it is declared to be a public nuisance to permit weeds, grasses or worthless vegetation to grow in excess of **10 inches** within the corporate limits of the City.
