Registration is open from January 1st - February 1st.

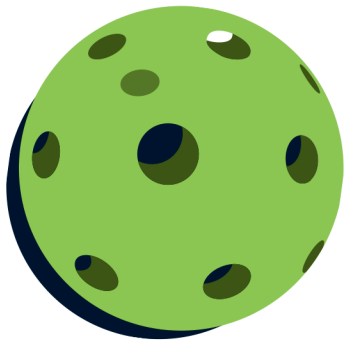

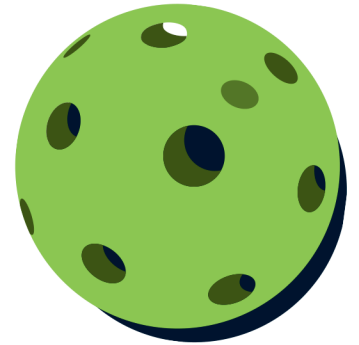
