GOLF CAR & ATV/UTV Reminders

All Golf Car -ATV/UTV City Registrations expired on December 31, 2022.

A Golf Car Vehicle or ATV/UTV may be operated on streets within the corporate limits of the City of Hickman ONLY if the operator and the vehicle comply with the following provisions:

- A Golf Car, All-terrain vehicle, utility-transport vehicle and mini-pickup may be operated only between the hours of sunrise and sunset.
- The headlight and taillight of the vehicle shall be fully operable and visible.
- Both Golf Cars and ATV/UTV shall be equipped with a bicycle safety flag which extends not less than 5 feet above ground attached to the rear of such vehicle. An ATV/UTV may have an electric strobe/flashing beacon mounted on the top of the vehicle in place of the bicycle safety flag.
- The vehicle shall have a visible, operational brake light system.
- Driver must have a valid Class O Operator's License to operate both an ATV/UTV or Golf Car. The driver may have a Farm Permit if operating an ATV/UTV.
- Driver must wear a helmet or hard hat when operating an ATV/UTV.
- Must have liability insurance coverage for the vehicle.
- Must be registered with the City of Hickman. The City will provide proof of registration sticker to the vehicle owner and said sticker must be prominently displayed on the rear of the vehicle.
- **Golf Cars and ATV/UTVs may NOT be operated on any city sidewalk or trail.**
