ALTERNATE DAY WATERING

Beginning May 1 and ending September 30
of each year

KNOW YOUR DAY

Consumers having odd numbered street addresses shall be permitted to water or irrigate their lawns on Tue, Thur, & Sat of each week

Even numbered street addresses shall be permitted to water or irrigate their lawns on Wed, Fri & Sun of each week



MONDAYS

No lawn watering or lawn irrigation shall be permitted on Monday of each week

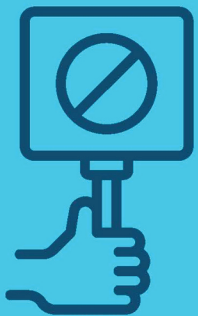
PENALTIES

1st Offense - Posted notification on the consumers property

2nd Offense - Written warning

3rd Offense - \$250 fee added to the consumer's monthly bill from the city

4th+ Offense - \$1000 fee added to the consumer's monthly bill from the city.



EXEMPTIONS

A 30 day exemption to the watering and lawn irrigation schedule is available for those consumers establishing new grass and for seasonal reseeded.
Contact the city offices for an application..

Watering Restrictions do not apply to washing of cars, driveways, houses, etc

SOLICITORS PERMITS ARE REQUIRED IN HICKMAN

Any person (not associated with a nonprofit organization) who is going door-to-door in Hickman passing out fliers or attempting to make sales of any kind must have a permit issued by the City of Hickman and must carry the permit on them while conducting business within the city. Citizens may request to see the permit from any solicitor and are encouraged to report violations of Municipal Code 5-402 to City Hall 402-792-2212 or report on our website under:

IMPORTANT BRUSH PILE INFORMATION

**Please be aware the brush pile cannot accept any trash,
lumber, or bags.** Items allowed in the brush pile are limited to tree
limbs, shrubs, leaves, and grass clippings. Residents utilizing the brush pile
should be aware that if prohibited items are found, the Lincoln-Lancaster
County Health Department could revoke the City's open burn permit
resulting in the permanent closing of the brush pile.

Brush pile facility keys are available for checkout by residents that live
within the city limits of Hickman at City Hall, 115 Locust Street. Keys can
be checked out overnight (24 hrs.) and returned to the drop box located in
front of City Hall.

Lost keys, or keys not returned, are subject to a \$25 fee.
