June 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30 from 10 am to 10 pm

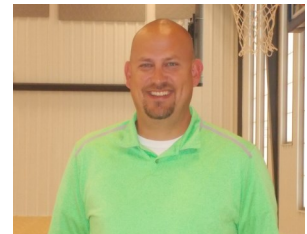
July 1, 2, 3 from 10 am to 11 pm
