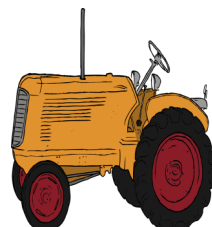
Hickman Area Reading Centre

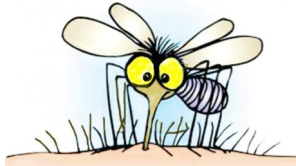

NOTICE TO RESIDENTS OF HICKMAN



The City of Hickman will be spraying mosquitos starting the last week of May and continuing through the months of June, July and August.

The City will also start flushing fire hydrants the last week of May and will continue through the months of June, July and August. This may cause some discoloration of the water. Please check your water before using.

Reminder of the City of Hickman Municipal Codes:

Chapter 6-302 Duty of the occupant of each lot to keep the sidewalk adjacent thereto free of overhanging branches and limbs to a height of eight (8) feet and keep shrubbery and hedges from encroaching on the sidewalk.

Chapter 6-304 Sidewalk Maintenance – Every owner of any lot shall at all times keep and maintain the sidewalk contiguous to said lot in good and proper repair and in a condition reasonably safe for travel.

Per Ordinance 2014-07 adopted April 22, 2014 amending Municipal Code Section 3-502: Weeds or Grasses; Public Nuisance - It is hereby declared to be a public nuisance to permit weeds, grasses or worthless vegetation to grow in excess of 10 inches on any property within the corporate limits of the City.

GRASS CLIPPINGS CANNOT be left in the street. Clippings get washed into the storm sewer drains, by rains and other means, clogging drains, and cause needless repairs. Therefore, make sure your clippings are not in the street.

The city brush pile is for tree limbs, grass clippings, and general yard waste. Please do not leave plastic bags, construction material or garbage at this site. City of Hickman residents may check out a key at the City Office.
