## 68TH & HICKMAN ROAD ROUNDABOUT

Construction of the New Roundabout at the 68th & Hickman Road is in progress!

The intersection is expected to close July 5 and reopen to traffic at the end of September. Once the roundabout is completed and the intersection is back open, 68th Street north of Prairie View Lane will close for construction of a trail underpass.

This segment of 68th Street is expected to reopen to traffic in mid-November.

**Access to all local businesses will remain open during all phases of construction.**

Through traffic traveling around Hickman should use the marked detour on 54th Street, Roca Road, 82nd Street and Panama Road.
