Hickman Main Park Improvements

In 2012, the City of Hickman's Parks Department staff created a vision for Main Park improvements that could be completed over multiple phases and years. The Parks Department is funded by a combination of new construction Parks Infrastructure Fees of \$700.00 per house and business, sales tax and property tax revenue. While keeping our property tax levy flat, the Mayor and City Council budgeted for the following improvements:

2013: Construction of the Baseball and Softball Field Crow's Nests

2014 - 2015: Construction of the new Concession Stand and Restrooms

2015: Removal of the tennis courts and old playground equipment; Phase one construction of the new playground equipment including large play structure and swings

2017: Trail addition and bank stabilization project west and north of T-Ball Field

2019 (2018 & 2019 Budget): Phase two construction of the playground equipment, trail replacement and new shelter

Infinity 8 - Fiber Installation

Infinity 8 Broadband, through a Franchise Agreement with the City of Hickman, is continuing construction of fiber to houses in Hickman.

Fiber construction within the Prairie View, Baylor Heights and most of Arbor Ridge is complete.

Construction will begin in Wagon Train Heights and within Olde Towne this summer.

Please be aware the construction is taking place in the City's utility easements within and near private property. One-Call utility flagging will continue to identify locations of the project.
