Electric Vehicle Charging Station Incentive Pilot Program

A \$200 EnergyWise incentive for the installation of a residential vehicle charging station is available for a limited time from Norris Public Power District. This incentive is for

customers who purchase an electric vehicle and choose to install a ChargePoint 32 amp Wi-Fi enabled station. Other charging stations may be incented but must pass pre-approval criteria. To qualify for the pilot incentive program, the installation location of the charging station must have internet wireless connectivity.

- 1. Purchase and install a ChargePoint 240V 32A Wi-Fi connected charging station at your home.
- 2. Activate the charging station with the ChargePoint app.
- 3. Download and fill out the EnergyWise <u>Electric Vehicle Charging Station</u> Incentive Pilot Program application.
- Submit your completed application to Norris Public Power District who will verify that the installation meets the program criteria before issuing any incentive.
- 5. By signing the application, you agree to release your charging station energy usage data to Norris Public Power District.
