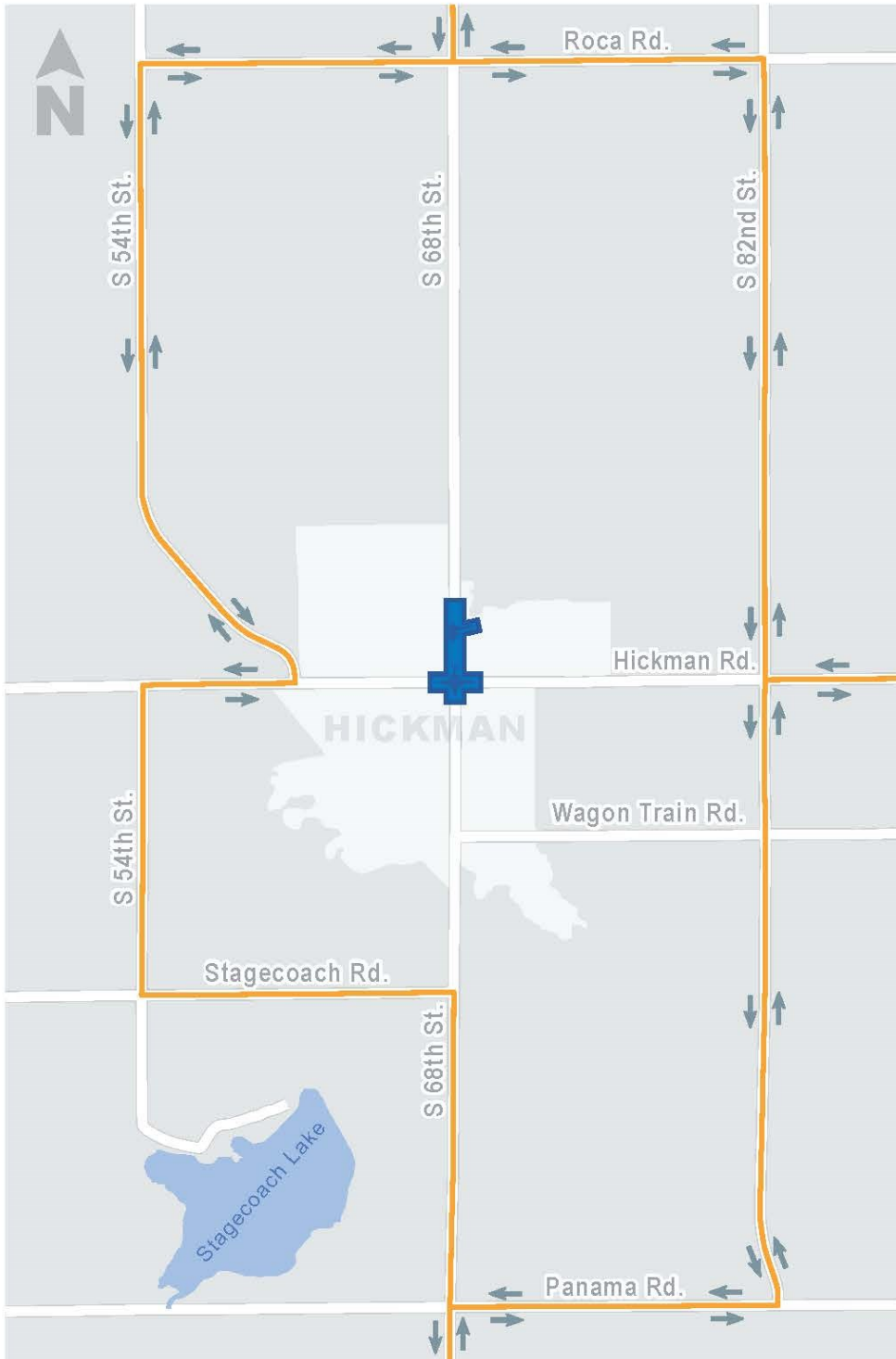

South 68th Street & Hickman Road Improvement Project



Heads Up, Hickman!

Improvements are coming to the intersection of 68th St. & Hickman Road this summer.

The intersection is anticipated to close in early July for construction of a roundabout at the intersection which will increase safety and traffic flow for vehicles, pedestrians and bicyclists.

Along with the roundabout, a trail underpass will be constructed to connect trail users to the east and west sides of Hickman.

Improvements will also be made to address drainage issues to the north.

Access to all businesses and properties will remain open to local traffic during construction. Through traffic should use the marked detour on S. 54th St., Roca Rd., S. 82nd St., and Panama Rd.

The intersection is expected to be open to traffic at the end of September.

ATV/UTV Reminders

An all-terrain vehicle, utility-transport vehicle and mini-pickup may be operated only between the hours of sunrise and sunset.

The headlight and taillight of the vehicle shall be fully operable and visible.

The vehicle shall be equipped with an electric strobe/flashing beacon mounted on the top of the vehicle or a bicycle safety flag which extends not less than five feet above ground attached to the rear of such vehicle.

The vehicle shall have a visible, operational brake light system.

Driver must have a valid Class O operator's license or a farm permit.

Must wear a helmet or hard hat.

Have liability insurance coverage for the all terrain vehicle.
