allowed in the brush pile.


**NO— Lumber, Garbage, bags,

**YES! You can drive your Registered
Golf Car/ATV/UTV on City Streets!
(but NOT the Trails or Sidewalks)
(ORD2016-24 & ORD2008-12)**

All golf cars operating within the
city limits must be registered
with the City of Hickman.

Basic Rules

- *Cannot be parked or driven on any
city trail or sidewalk.
- *Operated only between the hours of
sunrise to sunset.
- *Vehicle must be equipped with a
bicycle flag.
- *Must be operated by persons with a
valid Class O operators license.
- *City issued registration sticker must
be displayed on the rear of vehicle.
