

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HICKMAN, NEBRASKA, AMENDING THE DEFINITIONS OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES AND UTILITY-TRANSPORT VEHICLES; ADDING A NEW SECTION 4-405 (G); REPEALING ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HICKMAN, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Section 4-405(A) be and hereby is amended to read as follows: A.

For purposes of this section:

1. "All-terrain vehicle" (ATV) means any motorized off-highway vehicle which (1) is 50 inches or less in width, (2) has a dry weight of 1,200 pounds or less, (3) travels on three or more non-highway tires, and (4) is designed for operator use only with no passengers or is specifically designed by the original manufacturer for the operator and one passenger. (Neb. Rev. Stat. §60-6,355)
2. "Utility-type vehicle" (UTV) means any motorized off-highway vehicle which (1) is 74 inches in width or less, (2) is not more than 180 inches in length, including the bumper, (3) has a dry weight of 2,000 pounds or less, and (4) travels on four or more non-highway tires. "Utility-type vehicle" does not include all-terrain vehicles, ATV / UTVs, or low-speed vehicles. (Neb. Rev. Stat. §60-6,355)
3. "Street" or "highway" means the entire width between the boundary limits of any street, road, avenue, boulevard, or way, which is publicly maintained when any part thereof is open to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular travel. (Neb. Rev. Stat. §60-624)

SECTION 2. That Section 4-405(G) be added to read as follows:

G. The ATV / UTV must be registered with the City of Hickman. The City will provide proof of registration sticker or tag to the vehicle owner, and said sticker or tag must be prominently displayed on the rear of the vehicle. To obtain a registration sticker or tag from the City, a signed registration form that includes this Ordinance's provisions must be completed. Proof of insurance must also be provided and a registration fee paid. The registration fee for ATV/UTV Vehicles will be adopted by ordinance per the Master Fee Schedule. All registrations will expire on December 31 of each calendar year.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law.



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HICKMAN, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Section 4-405(A) be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

A. For purposes of this section:

1. "All-terrain vehicle" (ATV) means any motorized off-highway vehicle which (1) is 50 inches or less in width, (2) has a dry weight of 1,200 pounds or less, (3) travels on three or more non-highway tires, and (4) is designed for operator use only with no passengers or is specifically designed by the original manufacturer for the operator and one passenger (Neb. 2. "Utility-type vehicle" (UTV) means any motorized off-highway vehicle which (1) is

74 inches in width or less, (2) is not more than 180 inches in length, including the bumper, (3) has a dry weight of 2,000 pounds or less, and (4) travels on four or more non-highway tires. "Utility-type vehicle" does not include all-terrain vehicles, ATV / UTVs, or low-speed vehicles. (Neb. Rev. Stat. §60-6,355)

3. "Street" or "highway" means the entire width between the boundary limits of any street, road, avenue, boulevard, or way, which is publicly maintained when any part thereof is open to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular travel. (Neb. Rev. Stat. §60-624)

SECTION 2. That Section 4-405(G) be added to read as follows:

G. The ATV / UTV must be registered with the City of Hickman. The City will provide proof of registration sticker or tag to the vehicle owner, and said sticker or tag must be prominently displayed on the rear of the vehicle. To obtain a registration sticker or tag from the City, a signed registration form that includes this Ordinance's provisions must be completed. Proof of insurance must also be provided and a registration fee paid. The registration fee for ATV/UTV will be adopted by ordinance per the Master Fee Schedule. All registrations will expire on December 31 of each calendar year.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
